INTERNATIONAL SYMPOSIUM ON ADVANCING THE CHEMICAL SCIENCES (ISACS)

Dear Professor Li

We would like to formally invite you, on behalf of the Scientific Organising Committee, to present a plenary lecture at the forthcoming **17th International Conference on Advancing the Chemical Sciences (ISACS 17)**.

The theme of this conference is "**Challenges in Chemical Renewable Energy**". The meeting will be held in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil from **8-11 September 2015**. This is the follow-up to the very successful ISACS 4 and 12 which took place in 2011 (Boston, USA) and 2013 (Cambridge, USA). To see who spoke visit www.rsc.org/isacs.

The format will be a single stream of around 10-12 plenary lectures, each lasting 45 minutes; this will be complemented by a number of poster sessions and 10-15 invited lectures. These will be selected from submitted abstracts.

The ISACS symposia were launched in July 2010 with three meetings being held over three continents (USA, Europe and Asia) over three weeks to support the launch of the flagship Royal Society of Chemistry journal *Chemical Science*. Now in their sixth year we are delighted to be able to continue this new global symposia series in 2015 with a further three meetings. We are asking all invited speakers to support *Chemical Science* by submitting a manuscript for publication during 2015 - 2016. *Chemical Science* is the flagship journal from the Royal Society of Chemistry with an impact factor of 8.6 (Thomson Reuters 2013). *Chemical Science* recently announced that from 2015 all articles will be published Open Access and, for at least two years, the Royal Society of Chemistry will waive all Article Processing Charges (APCs) making publication free for authors and readers. We are delighted to be able support the community and advance excellent science in this way.
