Dear Prof. Yang,

It gives us great pleasure to invite you to the *Department of Dynamics at Surfaces Workshop on Modern Topics in Chemical Physics*. We are convening this workshop to further student interactions with world renowned scientists. The meeting will be largely composed of student and post-doc presentations from members of the Department of Dynamics at Surfaces, with a select number of plenary lectures, to which we hope you will be willing to contribute. We plan 1 hour for your presentation including 15 minutes of discussion. We request that you provide a pedagogically oriented introduction, but of course the majority of your talk should be on topics representing your latest scientific interests and accomplishments.

The meeting will take place at Schloß Ringberg of the Max Planck Society (<http://www.schloss-ringberg.mpg.de/>) from May 18th (arrival 4 pm) until May 21st (departure after lunch) 2014. Schloss Ringberg is located in the foothills of the Bavarian Alps in the direct vicinity of the Tegernsee. The castle was built in the early part of the 20th century and willed to the Max Planck Society in 1967. Since then, the Max Planck Society has transformed Schloss Ringberg into a truly unique meeting place where scientists can exchange ideas and discuss problems with their colleagues from all over the world in beautiful surroundings and in a relaxed mountain atmosphere. It now ranks as one of the most sought after conference sites in Germany.

Accommodation and travel costs will be fully reimbursed by us. For organizational purposes we would appreciate receiving an attendance confirmation no later than December 1st. We look forward to your acceptance and to seeing you in Ringberg.
